BOGOTÁ, COLOMBIA

Bogotá is simply the union of the best of Colombia—an endless city to explore.



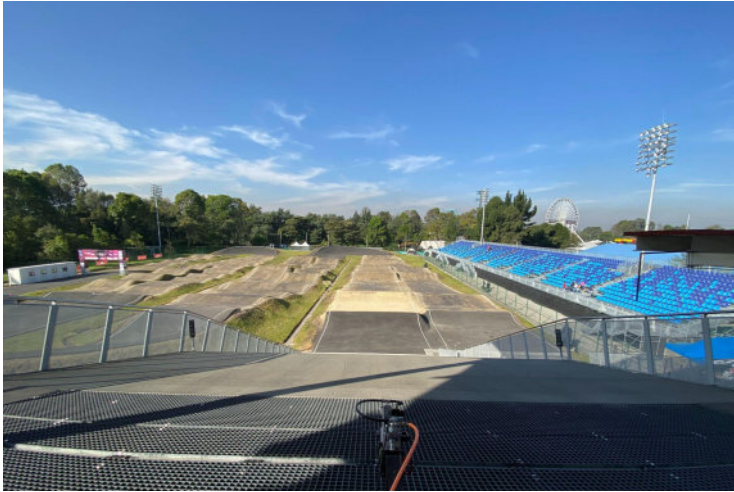

CARLOS RAMIREZ BMX TRACK

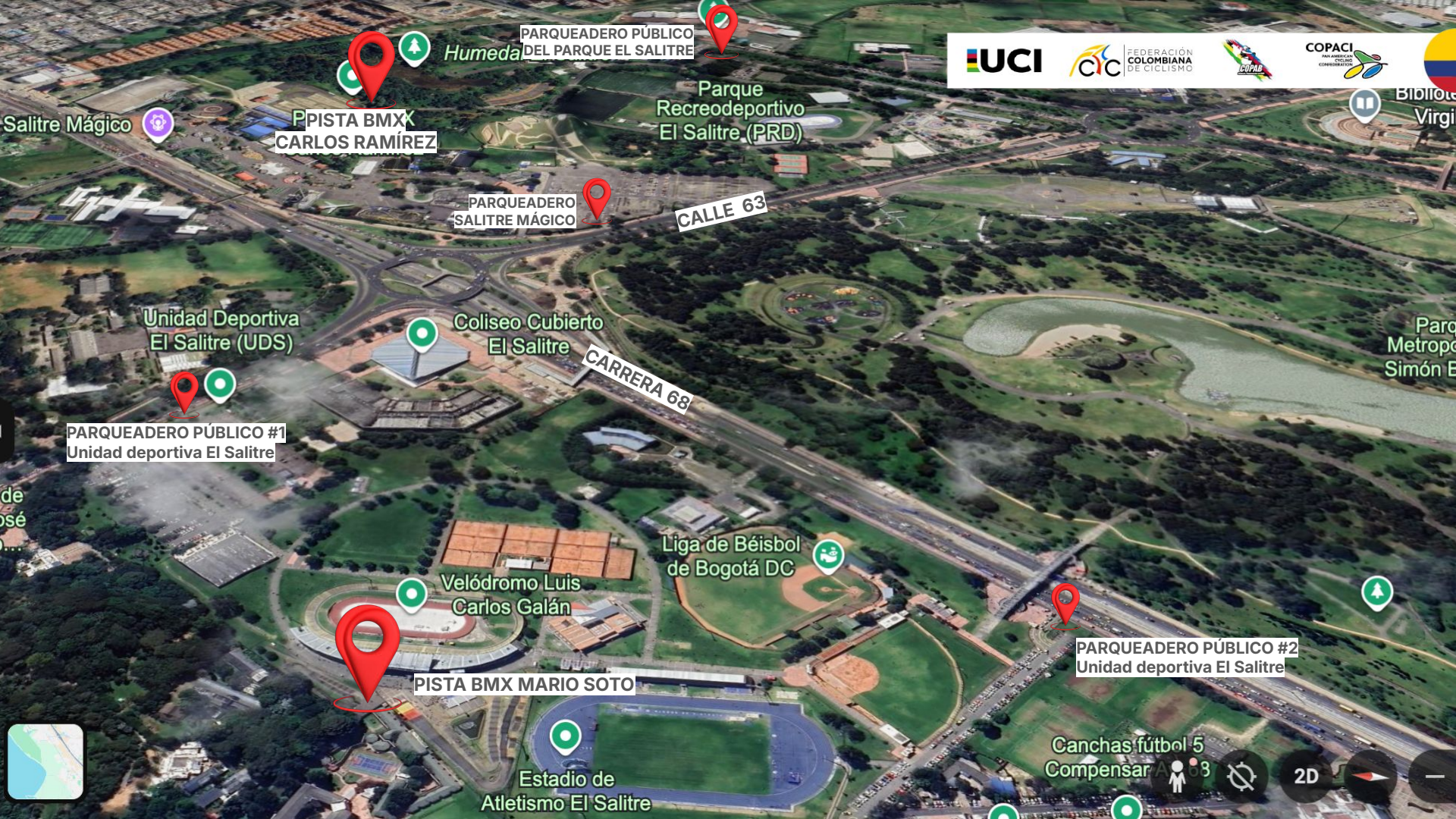
Located at the **El Salitre Recreational and Sports Park**, Carrera 60 No. 63-65. The track's first phase includes: **13,000 m² area, 150 linear meters of competition track**, Two parallel circuits with metal start ramps of **8 meters and 5 meters** (Supercross Line and Challenger Line), **8 racing lanes**.

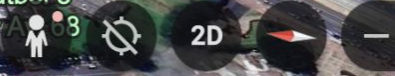

All riders who wish to participate and hold a valid **UCI license**, and who belong to UCI-COPAB affiliated federations, may take part in the Latin American Cup.

Important clarification:

Round 3 - CC Category: Only riders from the American continent may participate.

Round 4 – C1 Category: Riders from all countries worldwide may participate.

Registration

Registration must be completed through each country's **National Federation**. For Colombian riders, registration must be completed through the corresponding **Cycling League and/or Departmental BMX Commission**.

Individual registrations will not be accepted. Registrations must be sent using the attached format to: **bmxfederacioncolombianadeciclismo.com** (cc: sergioescobar20@yahoo.es and linakatogui@hotmail.com).

The same email must include the names of officially accredited **delegates, coaches, press, and staff**, endorsed by the Federations and Cycling Leagues. Accreditation quotas are assigned according to the number of registered athletes.

MEDICAL INSURANCE: Medical insurance is mandatory for all foreign athletes, with a **minimum coverage of USD 60,000**, valid for the entire event.

Before using medical services, it is mandatory to first call the **Terrawind emergency line** to coordinate the required assistance (accident or illness).

Note: Even though medical providers are assigned, service activation must be initiated through the emergency call.

Colombian athletes will be covered by SURA insurance included with their national licenses. A valid federation license and active personal medical insurance are required.



Medical Assistance

Medical insurance is mandatory for all foreign athletes. Colombian athletes are not required to purchase this insurance, as they will be covered by the policy included in their National Federation license.

This insurance may be purchased through **Terrawind**, official sponsor of Colombian cycling, which offers preferential rates for delegations. The application process is as follows:



Coverage: 100% sports coverage with **USD 60,000** coverage limit.

Requests must be made **DIRECTLY by the applicant** via WhatsApp at **+57 324 511 0553**.

Process

The **Terrawind team** will validate the applicable product and send back the corresponding quotations. Once approved by the applicant, the coverage will be activated and a **payment link** will be sent.

After payment is completed and proof of payment is received, the corresponding **voucher will be sent via WhatsApp**.
